



Savannah Resources PLC (“Savannah”) is a mineral exploration company listed on the London AIM stock exchange (AIM: SAV) and is developing a lithium project in Barroso region, on which issue we make these newsletters. Savannah’s main goal is to provide the communities surrounding the project with information about the work completed and planned, so that the community is involved in this project so important for everyone.

### October at Mina do Barroso

Savannah remains committed with the needed works development that will allow the conclusion of the Environmental Impact Study (EIA). Thus, we have collected water in the Covas River, both upstream and downstream of the concession area, to carry out the necessary analyzes, and we have made monthly measurements of groundwater levels, important for the characterization of the current situation and the perception of possible influence of our activity at these levels.

The environmental monitoring of Mina do Barroso has been continuous. However, during September some important jobs restarted at Nucleo I - Alto da Misarela / NOA, namely regarding groundwater and air quality, that remained during the October month.

Regarding to the air quality, dust was measured by the installation of a dust collector in Couto de Dornelas, from 23 to 29 September, with the associated works taking place in Alto da Misarela, inside of Mina do Barroso.

Covas do Barroso community will always be a priority for Savannah, so we want to share with you all the investment that will be made in Mina do Barroso, in terms of environmental issues and protection of the population. It will be invested approximately 4,2 million euros in roads that will ensure that truck traffic will be routed directly outside the localities. Alternative roads for traffic diversion will also be opened to quarry vehicles, which will additionally reduce current traffic. All this investment will be, at the end of the project, for the exclusive benefit of the region.

Savannah considers important to share the jobs we will have available in the project, as we think they will be a benefit to the community. Therefore, and as it has sometimes been reported, 250 to 300 direct jobs will be created. In these jobs are considered some functions as: machine operators, administrative, maintenance, general service employees, assistants in various areas, geologists, drivers, doctors, nurses, cleaning people, cooks and kitchen assistant, among others.

Barroso Mine is open to the community, so we invite you to the Information Center and request a visit to the entire area of the mine. We will be able to receive 3 visitors at a time, for which we have the appropriate protections for a safe visit to the mine, at a scheduled date and time depending on the work in progress. These visits will be scheduled from December.

**Savannah asks for the understanding of the entire community of Covas do Barroso to the resume of drilling work at the Grandão and NOA (Alto da Misarela). The works began in the early days of October, and it's intended to continue drilling for the EIA completion surveys and it has been limited to Savannah lands. These works will continue during the month of November. Savannah is available to provide any clarifications the community deems necessary.**
