Submission of Environmental Impact Study to the Portuguese Environment Agency

Savannah delivered to the Portuguese Environment Agency (APA) the Environmental Impact Study and the Mining Plan for Mina do Barroso, which will now go through an analysis process, requests for additional information and subsequent public discussion.

The Study and the Plan were delivered in a preliminary study phase, contemplating three alternatives studied for the infrastructures, layout of the pits and phasing of the exploration. The appropriate studies were presented to key bodies but it will be APA and DGEG that will analyze and verify all the information, so that both are in full compliance with the requirements for the development and operation of the project.

The Savannah team, supported by several independent environmental consultants, carried out numerous research activities, surveys of the reference situation and several studies, in order to develop the best mining project for Mina do Barroso. The company's concerns were particularly the well-being of the community and care for the environment.

In this way, we are able to ensure that the documents specify all aspects of the mine, from the intervention plans to the final environmental recovery project when the exploration is finished. As a basis were the habits and way of life of the local community, the rurality of the region, the importance of agriculture, the quality of water and air, among many other determining factors in an exhaustive study that presents concrete and precise results on the concession area and where measures that eliminate, minimize or compensate for possible negative impacts are also presented.

It is with this concern that we intend to maintain close contact with the authorities and local communities. Our daily work involves continuing to cooperate with the region, in order to bring significant local added value through a project that we believe to be well structured, with rigorous environmental care, with real benefits for the local community and with real benefits at the level socioeconomic.

The current restrictions caused by the Covid-19 pandemic have caused some limitations in the lives of all of us, but we believe that we will all be able to overcome them in the best way. We are still very pleased to realise that the Boticas region is still without positive cases, and in order to continue to ensure the necessary social distance, Savannah still keeps the Information Center and office closed.

We expect to resume the engagement program with landowners soon, with the necessary limitations in view of the recommendations that remain. We are fully available for any questions through our usual contacts.

The Benefit Sharing Program is one of our current top priorities. Our commitment is to discuss it with all interested parties, Mayor of Boticas, Community, Baldios CdB, CdB Parish Council and all involved, adapt it as best as possible to local needs and expectations, and present it very soon. In parallel, all necessary elimination and/or mitigation measures will be maintained to deal with possible negative impacts, as well as compensatory measures.

Savannah wants everyone to stay safe and healthy, and the Boticas region to continue without cases. We reinforce that we remain available for any support that is necessary and within reach.

We remind you that the Community Information Center remains closed. We will inform stakeholders once we are able to reopen the Center. At that time, we will keep the previous schedule, Tuesdays from 10am to 12:30pm and Wednesdays from 3pm to 5:30pm.
