



Savannah Resources PLC (“Savannah”) is a mineral exploration company listed on the London AIM stock exchange (AIM: SAV) and is developing a lithium project in the Barroso region, which is the subject of these newsletters. Savannah’s main goal is to provide the communities surrounding the project with a regular flow of information on work underway and planned. The Mina do Barroso Project will bring exceptional economic, demographic, social and business opportunities to the Barroso region while at the same time implementing world’s best environmental management practices.

September & October at Mina do Barroso

The comprehensive Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) remains Savannah's top priority. Delivered to the APA at the beginning of June, its evaluation began to be made immediately. The request for additional information came in August, so we have our team, supported by several specialized and independent environmental consultants who developed the study, exclusively dedicated to working on the study and collecting the required information requested. We anticipate that the delivery of this information will take place in the coming weeks, after which the APA will finish its assessment and place the EIA for public consultation.

We are convinced that the EIA will provide the facts based evidence to our stakeholders to help them develop their understanding of Mina do Barroso and that our project that has been studied and analyzed in depth. It is our intention to apply the best practices used worldwide.

Savannah intends to make a series of public presentations on the subject to help all those interested in understanding the study and work carried out and to receive feedback and promote informed discussion. We plan the presentations to Covas do Barroso, Dornelas and Boticas, to be agreed in advance with the local authorities and also with the exceptional concern, the pandemic that we are all experiencing.

Savannah's concern is related not only to the environment around the towns of Covas do Barroso and Dornelas, but also to their communities. We intend to maintain engagement with the population in an open way, while listening and transmitting all information clearly and precisely, communicating consistent facts in order to promote trust and reinforce our commitment. In this sense, we intend to carry out a joint work, so that it is possible to achieve mutually beneficial results.

For the Barroso Mine project, we defend, apply and commit ourselves to sustainable and responsible mining. We want to be a pioneer in this concept in Portugal. The importance given to the environment, natural resources and the way we treat and value the planet is increasingly evident. The Barroso Mine was designed to apply the best practices of “green and smart mining” (“green & smart mining”), so we hope to turn our project into a global example with regard to the management of water, minerals, energy and resources, ensuring the reduction of the environmental footprint.


More than an environmental concept, Savannah's concern with the municipality of Boticas extends to several areas that involve the mining project, namely, in the mitigation of social, ecological and technical problems, and also working together with the authorities and populations locations.

The energy used in the Barroso Mine will come from renewable sources, in particular, solar energy. To this end, the intention is to build a solar energy park that will support the energy costs of the mine, while enabling the sharing of green energy with the nearest populations, ensuring lower electricity bills.

This plan also includes environmental restoration that benefits the region and the entire community. Our goal is to progressively rehabilitate the land, in order to allow a future of sustainable use, for tourism, energy and agricultural purposes that are safe, valued and that can have different uses for the population.

During the past few months, field work has also been done, duly agreed with the local authorities and entities. Noise and water monitoring was carried out in order to comply with the legal obligations provided for. These reports are sent annually to APA, which is in charge of carrying out their analysis.

Additionally, 3 prospecting platforms were rehabilitated in the Pinheiro area, which Savannah had committed to undertake. The rehabilitation of 3 more prospecting platforms is expected in the near future, which will be agreed with the local authorities and entities in a timely manner.



The engagement program with the landowners, following the necessary rules of protection and distance, is again active, our team is available to gather, visit and evaluate the properties that are available for sale.

We continue to develop the Benefit Sharing Program, which is one of our main commitments to stakeholders, Mayor of Boticas, Community, Baldios CdB, CdB Parish Council and everyone involved. It will soon be presented, together with the proposed elimination and / or mitigation measures.

Although there are now cases of Covid-19 in the municipality of Boticas, we wish that everyone remains safe and healthy, without major complications. We reinforce that we remain available for any support that is necessary and within reach.
