Savannah recognises the importance of providing accurate and detailed information to facilitate a comprehensive understanding of the Barroso Lithium Project. This factsheet has been developed with the aim of providing precise details of the Project's size in terms of its surface footprint.


1. How big is the Project area?

C-100 CONCESSION

The Project will be located on the C-100 Concession Area which covers 542 hectares. Savannah is proposing to extend this area by 9% to 593 hectares. The enlarged Concession Area equates to 2% of the area of the Boticas Municipality, or 9% of the combined area of the Covas do Barroso and Dornelas Parishes.


2. How do the mining areas on the C-100 concession area compare to other facilities locally?


The total area that will be used for mining on the Concession Area is 71 hectares, or less than 12% of the Concession's enlarged footprint. This area equates to about 4 times the size of the Resinorte's waste facility, or 5 times the exploitation area at the Britanteros' quarry (located in Vila Pouca de Aguiar). Furthermore, due to the sequential nature of the mining, with no more than two of the four proposed mining areas operating at the same time, this total surface expression will not occur at the same time.
